6.5.3 Quality assurance initiatives of the Institutions (2016-17)

Kamla Nehru College of Pharmacy started in the year 2006 Under the leadership of ADV. Shri Abhijitji Wanjarri Secretary- Amar Sewa mandal Nagpur- with the vision "To develop well trainees competent pharmacy professionals to meet the expectations of healthcare system.

The academic session of college was commenced on 16th June 2016. In the academic session 2016-17, 201 students were enrolled in B. Pharm and 11 students in M. Pharm. The college library has a collection of 7373 books and subscription of 22 journals, 01 e-journal and 05 newspapers.

Our college started functioning new girl's hostel building comprising 33 rooms with accommodation facility of 96 girls from September 2016. Hostel building was inaugurated by the hands of Adv. Shri Abhijitji Wanjarri, Secretary Amar Sewa Mandal Nagpur, and Mrs. Smita Wanjari, Treasurer Amar Sewa Mandal Nagpur. Second is, on 18th October Dr. Jagdish Baheti a young and enthusiastic academician taken charge as Principal of kamla Nehru college of Pharmacy.

The performance of our students in the University Examinations is consistently well. B. Pharm Final year result is 85% and, M. Pharm final semester result is 100 %.

In the NSS Unit of the college, 52 students were enrolled. College has adopted Village Shirul, which is nearer to Butibori. NSS wing organized special camp at Shirul village between 26th December to 31st December 2016. During this period, students, staff and the villagers actively participated in 'Swacchata abhiyan'.

College has conducted 03 certificate courses on Route of Administration & Animal Handling techniques, Hand on training on Sophisticated instruments and Preclinical evaluation of CNS acting Drugs.

College organized three soft skill programs for students as Communication Strategy, Language and communication, and Approaches to Professional development. Stress management & Yoga & Meditation workshops was arranged along with ICT/Computing skill program.
