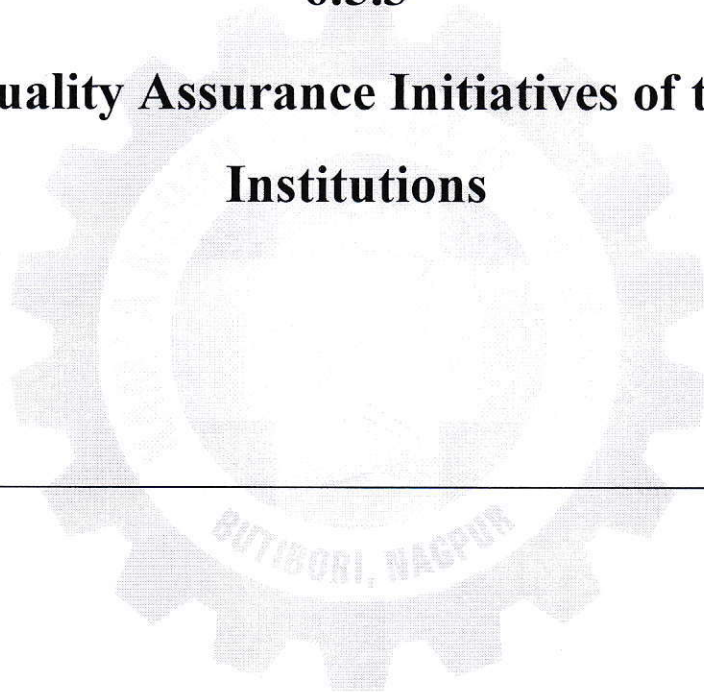

The academic session of college was commenced from 16th June 2018. College prepared academic calendar highlighting day to day activity. 02 students awarded Ph. D under the guidance of Dr. Jagdish Baheti.

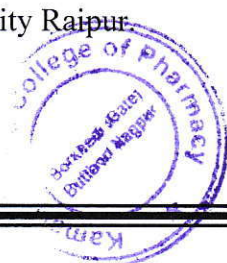
02 candidates were awarded Ph. D degree under the guidance of Dr. S. N. Umathe sir.

Annual Reports for Year 2017-18

The academic session of college was commenced on 16th June 2016. In the academic session 2017-18, 233 students were enrolled in B. Pharm and M. Pharm. The college library has a collection of 8659 books and subscription of various journals, e-journal and newspapers. Teaching faculties applied for research grants for Government funding agencies. Out of these proposals, Dr. Jagdish Baheti, received the grant of Rs 1 Lac from Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB), Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India, New Delhi. The performance of our students in the University Examinations is consistently well. B. Pharm Final year result is 85% and, M. Pharm final semester result is 100 %.



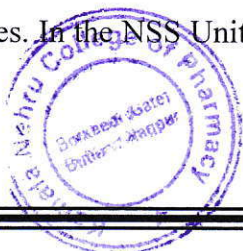
