Kamla Nehru College of Pharmacy started in the year 2006 with the vision "TO EXCEL THROUGH KNOWLEDGE, INNOVATION PASSION TO DEVELOP FUTURE PHARMACY PROFESSIONALS"

At the time of its inception, in 2006, the college offered B. PHARM course. In 2010, PG in Pharmaceutics and Pharmaceutical Chemistry was introduced.

In the academic session 2016-17, 201 students were enrolled in B. Pharm and 11 students in M. Pharm. The college library has a collection of 7373 books and subscription of 22 journals, 01 e-journal and 05 newspapers.

This year will be remembered for two things. First is, at Butibori, college new girl's hostel building comprising 33 rooms with accommodation facility of 96 girls started functioning from September 2016. University Results
