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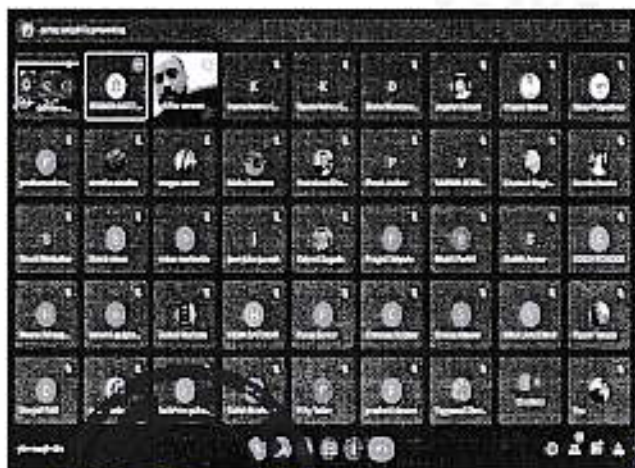
In a session, **Mr. Abhay Satyaki** highlighted

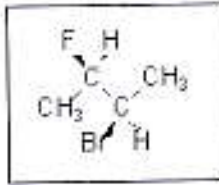
