
National Conference in Automation in Pharmaceutical Industry








bound through his interesting presentation of high-level technical facts with examples of applications from day-to-day routine. The QnA session was informative as well.

Second session on the topic; Digitization in Pharma Industry was found to be an extension of the first session. Dr. Pankaj Dhapke introduced the guest to the audience. As Mr. Sandeep Mantri, Head Mfg. Automation, at Biocon was also present at Mr. Rathi's session, he extended the points, like automation in pharma & smart decision making through his experiences in implementation of MES in Pharmaceuticals domain companies. He very well explained how the different



systems work in tandem to automate processes in the industry and are being monitored to make medications more accurately and flawlessly. The speaker expressed his readiness to answer any queries from the audience even after an extended QnA session was satisfactorily completed.
